This letter is to thank you most sincerely for yours and your staffs helping us out completely with the initial stages of construction on the underwater trail at Thompsons Bay.

Clearly, the underwater trail could not operate without secure anchors and with you being able to provide the concrete for the drums, we can rest assured that they will be resting comfortably on the bottom of the ocean and hopefully in the one spot for a long time to come.

Construction at this stage is proceeding rather slowly as we have been hampered somewhat by slightly larger seas than anticipated but at the minute we are hoping for westerly winds which will give us a flat sea and good working conditions.

I am sorry Kevin Condon from Pro-Dive has had some difficulty in getting out to you to collect the drums but he has been flat out with salvage jobs in Brisbane and Lord Howe Island. As I write, he is currently trying to find a ship up north somewhere. I trust the remaining drums to be collected from your yard are not inconveniencing you in any way. Please phone me immediately there is any problem.

Once again, many thanks Peter and as we get closer to completion I will keep you informed and hopefully we will be able to acknowledge publicly your assistance in this regard.
